



A MICE Course Board of industry experts is creating an international MICE curriculum to be taught in Thai universities, colleges and vocational schools. The curriculum will be based on insightful new MICE textbooks that will be taught at various levels, eventually up to bachelor degree program. To date, 106 institutions have signed an MOU to adopt the new course, which will also stipulate that course participants must organise a successful event to graduate.



MICE Curriculum

MICE Textbooks: Top MICE Minds

In 2012, the MICE Course Board published Asia's first MICE curriculum textbook, "Introduction to the MICE Industry," in both Thai and English. The textbook's 13 chapters highlight international best practices in the MICE industry, and will be used by leading Thai educational institutions in a new MICE course.

A second textbook currently being prepared will analyze Thai and international case studies from the MICE industry. The new publication, "MICE Case Book," will showcase how top professionals organise major events, pointing out the pros and cons of each event.

COACH THE COACHES PROGRAM





Open to all academic leaders, teachers and instructors from our allied universities and vocational schools. The program was launched in 2012, and has been conducted every year by gaining collaborations from MICE's association as speakers.



MICE ACADEMY & CAREER DAY





Providing MICE job opportunities from MICE association members to exhibit, and recruiting new graduates, and setting forum for MICE students to underst and more about job requirements, MICE Career Day project has plan to create new generations of high-quality MICE professionals with up to 5,000 university graduates and 1,000 college graduates by the 2020 academic year.

The event was launched in 2014, and has been conducted every year. We have a plan to expand it to 5 regions such as Northern, Southern, West, East and Northeast region.





MICE CAREER CENTER



MICE Career Center is an online resource to help MICE generations to meet all stages of professionals such as PCOs, PEOs, organizers and DMCs. This is a platform to help MICE students and alumni to pursue their career goals with a wide variety of offers to access in order to create their own profiles, career tools and individual career consultations specific to their background and goals. INITIATIVES

The MICE Academic Exchange Program will give lecturers, students and researchers a chance to gain new insights into the international MICE industry, by working with overseas partners to broaden Thailand's MICE curriculum and to raise standards of excellence in the industry.

TCEB bridges and builds international alliances among MICE institutions, with its inception in 2013, to bring Thai universities and to facilitate matching programs with international universities to form international alliances (8 Countries, 50 Organizations): Australia 2, China 1, Germany 8 (in the process), Japan 2, Korea 7, Taiwan 9, USA 1/22 (in the process).



MICE ACADEMIC CLUSTER





TCEB's MICE Capabilities Development Department collaborates with academic partners and leading universities in Thailand to form MICE Academic Cluster and work as a key mechanic to develop MICE's strengths with TCEB. There are 4 universities and 1 college with assigned area in each region.

The first launch in 2018 opened opportunities for all target groups to use our platform, at the conference, including scholars in MICE studies and those who have worked in the area of MICE development, to present paper/review articles related to MICE area. MICE STUDENT CHAPTER

Step-by-step to establishment of MICE Student Chapter

- Form up a team of 8 students and 1 lecturer
- Complete your information in Form 1 (application form). Then, return the document to TCEB for an official registration, and TCEB will send MICE Student Chapter Handbook later.

Student Chapters are established from the universities nationwide consisting groups of students from educational institution members. It is formed to fulfill the TCEB MICE Capabilities' objectives from the youth level. Student Chapter members, also known as the Future MICE Leaders (TCEB/FML), are often studying in the MICE, business events or related industry in service areas e.g. travel, tourism and hospitality field, and are passionate to bring changes. They execute projects and develop management skills as a team.

Currently, there are 62 universities as partners in assisting the local areas to grow the MICE industry.





MICE YOUTH CHALLENGE



MICE Youth Challenge is a session for knowledge exchanging that provides the students an opportunity to develop their creativity and to present outstanding ideas for the industry experience by bringing them to do business testing and to organize MICE events. Its does not only upgrade their skills, but also offers them with a great opportunity to meet professionals who will present case studies, working experience, training and recommendation. Each team needs to present project's conceptions, specialties, unique selling points, and convinces that Thailand is the best destination for hosting any terms of business events: MICE: M (meeting), I (incentive travel), C (conference) or E (exhibition).







INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

MEETINGS

Certified Meeting Professional (CMP)



The foremost certification of the meetings, conventions and exhibitions industry, the CMP program recognizes individuals who have achieved the industry's highest standard of professionalism. (3 years of experience are required.)

Certified Meeting Management (CMM)



This 3.5-day program mission is to select, educate, and certify management-level meeting and event professionals. The focus of the certificate is to provide continuing educational enhancements to the strategic decision-making ability of these leaders to manage and deliver exceptional meetings and events that drive organizational success. (7 years of experience are required.)

INCENTIVES

Certified Incentive Specialist (CIS)



In this 2-day entry level certification from SITE, individuals will learn the fundamentals of incentives, the origins of incentive programs and incentive travel, the value chain, the value proposition of motivational programs and non-cash awards, the composition of the market, the makings of a program and a program budget, industry tools and platforms and other valuable information.

CONVENTIONS

IAPCO Regional Seminar



In this 3-day program, participants will learn about the services and processes of professional conference management, and also learn more about the wider environment in which the clients, the PCOs, the convention bureau, venues and accommodation providers operate.

EXHIBITIONS



Certified in Exhibition Management (CEM)

This 9-day program provides a professional designation for individuals in the exhibitions and events industry. To earn the designation, participants must complete a nine-part program within three years. Recertification is required every three years after the initial program is completed to maintain the certification. (3 years of experience are required.)

Exhibition Management Degree (EMD)



This 150-hour (25-day) program trains exhibition industry professionals to meet tomorrow's event management demands.

VENUE MANAGEMENT

Certified Facilities Executive (CFE)



recognizes excellence in the professional development and competence of managers of public assembly facilities. The basic purpose is to provide additional incentive for professional improvement in public assembly facility management, and the primary purpose of this certification is to encourage professional development and to recognize achievement. (requires top 2 position level within venue.)

Certified Venue Professional (CVP)



recognizes the competence of middle to senior level managers of public assembly venues, as well as assists in creating a professional development road map. (3 years of experience are required.)

DESTINATION MANAGEMENT

Certified Destination Management Executive (CDME)



A 10-day program offering DMO industry's highest educational achievement, the Certified Destination Management Executive (CDME) Program seeks to enhance business acumen through an integrated executive program specifically designed for the Destination Marketing industry.

SPECIAL EVENT MANAGEMENT

Certified Special Events Professional (CSEP)



recognizes event professionals who have successfully demonstrated the knowledge, skills and ability essential to plan and execute all components of a special event. (3 years of experience are required.)

The National Certification Program is an initiative by MICE Capabilities, TCEB in strategic partnership with the Event Management Association (EMA), Thai Exhibition Association (TEA) and Thailand Incentive and Convention Association (TICA).

It is designed to allow those who desire to acquire a comprehensive overview and various components and entities involved in MICE industry. It also provides the practical knowledge in planning and managing MICE events, gaining heavily from the insights of industry experts on trending issues while firmly supported by academic frameworks that will engender the confidence needed to develop and manage successful MICE events within a condensed timeframe.

The National Certification Program will be focused on MICE related events including:









The Speaker Bureau is an innovative digital network that connects MICE organizers with the most relevant thought leaders to easily find, screen and secure the experts including professors, business leaders, government officials and other professionals for their meetings and events.

The platform will provide MICE organizers with the ability to tap into the thought leaders, industry professionals such as CMP, CEM, CIS and researchers with a diverse portfolio of subject areas.







A collaboration from 5 parties, comprising Ministry of Labor, Thailand Convention and Exhibition Bureau, Event Management Association (EMA), Thai Exhibition Association (TEA) and Thailand Incentive and Convention Association (TICA), have made efforts to develop the world's first skill standard for individuals, targeting service providers and electricians for the MICE industry (Meetings, Incentives, Conventions and Exhibitions), which will be introduced in 2018 to enhance competitiveness and skills development to reach national skills standards of people in MICE industry in Thailand.

The two national skills standard committees are established with the aim to enhance the ability of the MICE electricians and MICE AV technicians to compete effectively in the global economy. It is hoped that this will be a major drive to enhance competitiveness of Thai workers to meet the growth of MICE industry.


